#### **CORE FUNCTION:**

Under the direction of the Administrator of the Literacy & Essential Skills Program and the Principal of St. Nicholas Adult High School, the LES Clerk is responsible for records management and reporting according to the Ministry of Training, Colleges & Universities guidelines for LES students. - helps set up meetings, administers membership renewals, liaises with staff, students, the public and other agencies
- produces and distributes flyers
- processes time sheets
- performs general office duties

### Performs financial activities:

- processes purchase orders, expense claims, and requisitions
- processes bus passes and tickets;
- maintains budget spreadsheets

Performs other duties, as assigned by the supervisor.
